We're looking for local people to train to do the job. You could be a school leaver or someone simply looking to get back into work. You just need to be motivated and keen.

How it works

Stage 1 - Traineeship

At the start, is an eight week programme training within our Caretaking Service beginning on Monday 16 October. You can continue to claim benefits while working toward a Level 1 qualification in Customer Services.



If you don't make the next step to an apprenticeship we'll help you to find other routes into work.

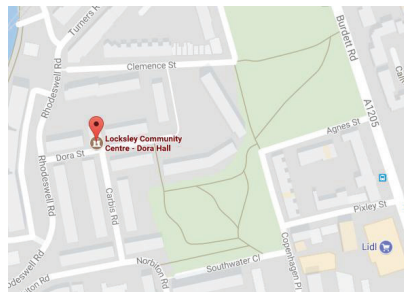
Stage 2 - Apprenticeship

You'll earn £7.50 an hour and work for 35 hours week. You will learn at work in a Caretaking Team with a structured training programme that lasts a year. You will be supported to achieve a Level 2 qualification in Facilities Management. And you can also apply for a job with us after 9 months of joining the programme.
