Any community or neighbourhood can set up a Neighbourhood Watch, which can be made up of just a few houses in a street, or a whole estate. Each Watch can be different, with OWL and there can be CCTV watches, business watches, Church, Hospital, Mosque, Residents Association, School, Synagogue and shop watches.
